




## **Installation Guide and PayPal module settings for the recurrent for Prestashop**

# How to install the module in Prestashop?

## Solution 1


Log in to admin panel Prestashop. Then, click the **Modules** tab and then click **Add a new module**.



Click on **Browse in the File** module to upload the module provided.

## Solution 2

If your server does not "unzip" module during installation or if you do not have rights to the server.


- ✓ Unzip the module on your desktop
- ✓ Upload the folder "paypalrec" in the directory "modules" of the remote server via ssh or ftp
- ✓ Log in to admin panel Prestashop
- ✓ The module appears in the list of modules

## Important

- ✓ For the good functioning of the module you should copy the file paypalrec-confirmation.php to the root of your server.
- ✓ Check that the directory **paypalrec** has the 755 rights

## How to configure the module as PrestaShop ?

Click **"Install"** module



Once installed click on "configure"

### **Sandbox Mode (2)**

This is a test mode provided by Paypal. You must register at <https://developer.paypal.com> before using this service.

### **Recurrences (3)**

Recurrences are monthly they can go up to 52.

### **Trigger (4)**

It is from this threshold that you will receive the payment split. In fact, if you want to display the payment split from 300 euros in order simply enter 250 in this field.

## **How are the payments in installements?**

At each deadline your client's order will be updated automatically in the back office of PrestaShop.
